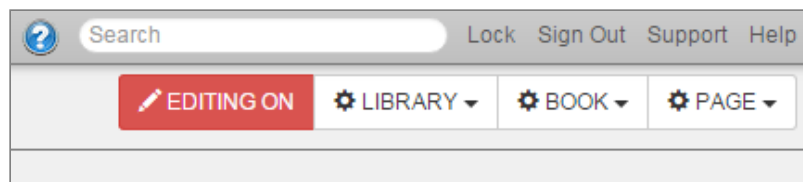
With Synergy LMS, teachers access everything they need in one place using LMS pages:

- Curriculum Elements
- Curriculum Maps
- Assignments
- Student work
- Assessments
- Performance analytics
- Digital resources
- Classroom management tools

Synergy LMS allows teachers to create web pages that contain the curriculum for their classes. You can make the LMS pages visible in ParentVUE and StudentVUE and replace Class Websites.

The hierarchy for LMS content is: **Library > Book > Page > Panel**. When you access the LMS, a default library opens that contains the necessary components for the page.

Rename the Default Library, Default Book, and Default Page to names you want to use using the menus.



Accessing LMS

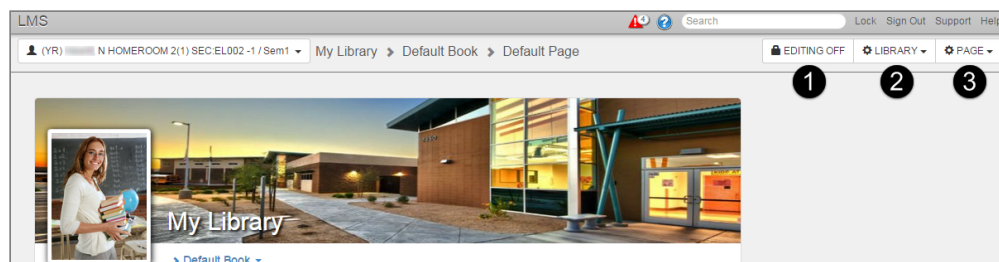
To view, add or edit curriculum maps, select *LMS* under the **LessonVUE** menu.

Users without access to Grade Book, access the LMS pages from **Synergy SIS > LMS > LMS**.

Navigate to **Synergy SIS > LMS > LMS**.

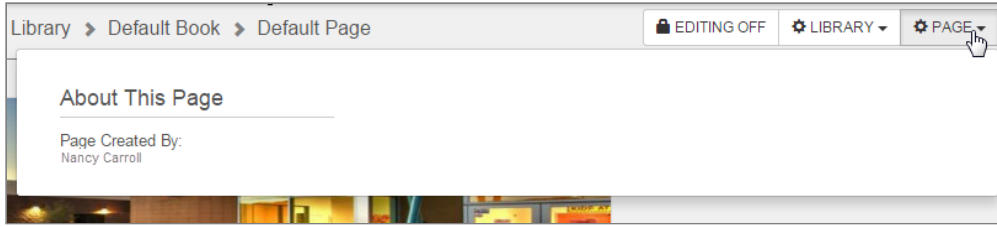
Users with access to Grade Book, access the LMS pages from the LessonVUE menu.
