- Curriculum that provides an easy transition between online learning and in-person instruction.






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One Platform: Canvas

- Students spending a large portion of their online instruction in Canvas, our online learning management system (LMS). From Canvas, students can
 - View and submit assignments
 - Connect with teachers and classmates
 - Take assessments

Students will access Canvas with their network username and password.



STRUCTURE & COMMUNICATION = SUCCESS

STRUCTURE:

Learning to build structure into your life is an essential component of success in the real-world.

Our aim is to give your student structured time daily with four hours of online instruction five days a week.

We've created space for students to work virtually, one-on-one with their teachers as needed.

COMMUNICATION:

Communication is vital to real-world success.

Frequent communication with teachers is vital to student success.

Multiple tools provided to connect with teachers: including Canvas messaging, email, phone, and scheduling office hours, etc.

Parents must be proactive by monitoring their student's learning and communicating regularly with teachers

Weekly Modules

- Teachers provide weekly modules each Monday morning so students understand exactly what's required in each class.
- The number and nature of each assignment is determined by each teacher as well as the requirements to earn a passing grade.
- Sharing course requirements with students establish clear student expectations.
- Please note, grades will NOT be issued on a Pass/Fail basis.
 Grades are earned on a typical A-F scale.

Office Hours: Everyday, Monday-Friday, 8:00 AM-11:00 AM

- Between 8:00am and 11:00am (M-F) teachers provide students the opportunity to schedule one-on-one or group tutoring sessions as capacity permits. All meetings are virtual.
- Students must reserve meeting times in advance.
- Students are encouraged to utilize office hours frequently to enhance their experience.

Attendance & Behavior

Attendance is taken daily. Daily login and participation are required. A portion of teachings occurs live, via Zoom and other technologies.

We understand some families require flexibility demonstrating attendance. In such cases must communicate with Administration and the teachers to determine what reasonable adjustments may be needed.
